2026-2027

Embodied Transitions has supported & empowered dance artists since 2023, and it is now expanding into a year-long program because its impact has been loud & widely felt. Dancers asked for more time, more depth, and more sustained support – and the transformations from past rounds made it clear that long-term guidance truly works.

This 1-year program is for dance artists who want to feel more rooted in their value, clearer in their direction, and more resourced in navigating the transitions that shape their artistic lives. Each month offers a focused theme, a rotating facilitator, shared movement practices, and a steady place to land, reflect, exchange, and grow.

The themes follow the natural rhythm of the seasons – Fall, Winter, Spring, and Summer – with a main umbrella theme each season and more detailed themes emerging in response to the group. This creates a structure that is held, yet co-created, allowing the program to evolve with the needs of the artists inside it.

You'll also have dedicated space to develop your own offerings – whether that's workshops, classes, performances, or new projects – so your work can reach further and your artistic life can become more sustainable.

When you move through this program, you'll walk away with a deeper understanding of who you are, the confidence to stand in your worth, and the practical tools to bring your work into the world with clarity and momentum.

When you feel supported and grounded in your value, your work resonates more widely, your community feels it, and you move through the world with an aliveness that creates real change.

You'll name what you're letting go of and what you choose to sustain as you move into the second half of the year.

JULY 5th, 12th, 19th: **ARTISTIC OFFERINGS & VALUE**

JULY 26th: OPEN WEEK: **The Offering Activation** - intentional week to refine, articulate, and activate your offering — clarifying its value, naming its worth, and preparing it to meet the world. Inner clarity becomes outer shape.

AUGUST 2nd, 9th, 16th: **STEPPING OUT & RECEIVING**

AUGUST 23rd: OPEN WEEK: **The Visibility Practice** - intentional week dedicated to stepping outward — sharing your offering, inviting opportunities, practicing visibility, and opening to receive the support, money, and resonance your work calls in. The work meets the world and the world responds.

AUGUST 30th: **3HR IN-PERSON END OF YEAR SEND-OFF CEREMONY:** a celebratory closing where we tie the whole year together - naming what you're stepping into next — the work you offer, the value you claim, and the support you are ready to receive as you move into your next chapter. Includes movement session, picnic and party! *time and place announced in March, 2027, virtual attendance also possible*

Alongside the group program, you're welcome to book private one-on-one sessions with the mentor of your choice if you'd like to dive deeper into any topic, explore personal questions, or receive more concentrated support for your artistic path.
